- 1. I'm an exercise science major with an emphasis in physical therapy and I love Lander's PEES program but to get prepared for a physical therapist certification program, I'm required to take general biology and chemistry courses, two of each. One of which is zoology, which is something I don't plan on applying to my future career I can understand general biology and chemistry, but don't understand zoology Lander makes it hard to complete programs on time because some classes don't get offered every semester; I'm required to take Anatomy and Physiology separately for my degree program because of the PT emphasis but I'm delayed a year because a class I needed for the exercise science program was dropped before registration therefore delaying my application to the program Things like this make it extremely difficult to still want to pursue my degree here because it doesn't feel like they care about their students
- 2. Lander is an amazing school
- 3. I think the tutoring center is very helpful. It would be nice to find a way to encourage students to go. I wish I would have started going earlier than I did.
- 4. Lander needs to do a better job at encouraging students to think of learning as a goal unto itself, and to seek out communities among their peers and foster relationships with professors as mentors and as people with whom they engage in discussion about ideas
- 5. Lander has small classroom sizes and the professors really seem to care about their students.

I feel that it is a resource that should be more available than what it is right now.
