1. Scope:

Lander University is seeking a qualified and insured flooring contractor to install Luxury Vinyl Tiles, LVT, in Brookside Student Housing Buildings # 02 and # 03. There are four other buildings are will be priced separately, and will be considered as bid alternates. The LVT flooring will be installed on top of the existing VCT flooring or over existing LVT.

- The complex consists of the following:
 - i. Seven (07) separate, 3-story wooden framed buildings.
 - ii. The Brookside Student Housing Complex was constructed in 1977.
 - iii. There are 20, 2-occupant living suites per building.
 - iv. There is a central stairwell in each building.
 - v. The first floor has a "community space" with LVT tile in Building # 01.
 - vi. The corridors are LVT tile in Building 01.
 - vii. The first floor has a "community space" with LVT tile in Buildings # 02-07.
 - viii. The corridors are VCT tile in Buildings # 02-07.
 - ix. Restrooms are not part of this project.
 - x. Lander University is providing floorplan schematics for the three respective floors for your convenience.
 - xi. If a building condition is discovered, where the contractor is concerned that direct flooring overlay is not recommended, the contractor shall bring the condition to the attention of the Lander University project representative. Any additional work will be negotiated via a construction change order.
 - xii. All interested contractors should make the effort to visit the site and verify all project dimensions prior to generating a competitive bid.
 - xiii. South Carolina LLR requires a "Non-Structural Renovation License", NR, to perform flooring projects where the value exceeds \$10,000.
- A. Lander University to take responsibility of moving suite furniture out of the way.
- B. Remove and dispose of the existing cove base (if applicable).
- C. Clean the floor of all debris and oils to prepare for the LVT overlay.
- D. Install LVT in all student suites (typical throughout the building): Terrain II 20 mil 0454V_color 05013 Orchard, 6"x48" Plank, 20 mil, 2.5 mm thick, direct glue See floorplan sketches for areas of installation.
- E. Install LVT in the building's public areas of the building.Crossing Paths 2.5 4431V_91518 Caster, 18"x18", 20 mil., 2.5mm, direct glue
- F. Install replacement cove base: (if applicable)

Shaw, total Worx, 94 Flint, 4 ½" x 1/8" rubber cove.

Construction Thermoplastic Rubber

Thickness 1/8" Size 4.5" x 48" G. Lander University to take responsibility of relocating the furniture back into the suite at the completion of work.

H. Debris / Material Disposal

i. The contractor is responsible for providing a waste container to serve as the only point of disposal of generated demolition / construction debris.




