Accepted Student Checklist *Welcome to Lander University!*

Housing

Please return the Housing Contract/Application to Residence Life as soon as possible. Early application for housing is encouraged; room assignments are made on a first come-first served basis. Your Housing packet will arrive days after you have been accepted. Please include your \$100 room confirmation fee and your \$75 security/damage deposit when submitting your contract.

Registration Deposit

Freshmen students are asked to send a \$100 registration tuition deposit to confirm your decision to attend Lander University. This deposit will be credited towards your tuition and fees in the fall. Students living on-campus are not required to pay both deposits. The \$100 room confirmation fee will confirm your attendance at Lander. Students must pay one of these deposits in order to be registered for classes.

Financial Aid

Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov, as soon as possible, after January 1. Students should contact the Office of Financial Aid, 864-388-8340 or visit online at www.lander.edu/finaid for detailed information concerning available aid and deadlines.

Final Transcript(s) Submission

Freshmen: Because admission is contingent on graduation from high school, Lander needs your final official high school transcript with the graduation date and GPA listed. For SC residents, this is necessary if you intend to qualify for the LIFE or HOPE scholarships.

Transfers: To ensure that proper credit is awarded for any transfer work from another institution, request a final transcript that includes all current and previous coursework completed. Do this for each institution attended. To be considered for the LIFE Scholarship, submit your final official high school transcript.

AP/IBC/Dual Enrollment Credit

Students who have taken Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate examinations may receive college credit. For dual enrollment credit, official transcripts must be sent from the university or college from which the credit is received. Official Score Reports/Official Transcripts should be sent to the Office of Admissions.

❑ Student Health Services

Submit the immunization form to Lander University Health Services prior to orientation and registration.

❑ EXPO/New Student Orientation

Please plan to attend one of two scheduled sessions of Lander University's Summer Orientation Program, known as EXPO. Your EXPO experience will be an exciting one focused on helping you connect to campus living, campus life, students in your chosen major, and the Greenwood community. You will also be able to meet your advisor and receive your schedule for the Fall Semester. Look for more information on EXPO registration in the spring.

❑ Placement Tests

All degree seeking freshmen are required to take an online math and foreign language placement tests. These tests are designed to appropriately place students in math and foreign language classes, based on demonstrated ability. These tests may be taken online before orientation.
