International Student Checklist

Must be proficient in English

- TOEFL test is required
 - Minimum score of 550 (80 if Internet-based)

Students who have received a degree from an American university

- SAT score may be required

Six months prior to attending:

- Complete application for admission (pages 1-4)
 - Complete application for international students (page 6)
- Send official copies of your transcripts
 - Official English translation of the subjects you studied
 - Official grade you earned in each subject
 - College-level work at a foreign college

Must have your transcripts evaluated by World Education Services (WES)
- Affidavit of support document
 - Indicate source of funds available (official bank statement)
 - No more than six months old
 - Must be submitted before an admissions decision can be made

Upon acceptance:

- Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20) will be sent
- Form I-20 is required for you to apply for an F-1 student visa
- Student is required to purchase insurance
 - United States has no public health care service
