

JUNIOR CHECKLIST

- Begin researching colleges through college guides or websites.
 - Visit Lander website at www.lander.edu
- Check with your high school guidance counselor to make sure you are enrolled in college prep classes and you will meet the general requirements for college. Lander requires: four units of CP English, three units of math, three units of science, two units of social studies, one unit of US History, one unit of PE/ROTC, two units of the same foreign language, and four electives.
- Prepare for the PSAT
 - Visit www.collegeboard.com for a practice test
- List 10 colleges you are interested in and research the special requirements for each college.
- Take the SAT/ACT and send your scores to Lander.

- Make a short list of 5 colleges you want to visit.
