Remember: Choose the correct link. If you are accessing the database and are not on campus, then select “Off Campus Users Click Here”. For Off-Campus Access, you need to use your last name and L Number).

- Allows you to search by “author” or “work”. (e.g. Hemingway, Earnest (author) or “Hills like White Elephants” (Work).
- *Very* useful when for looking for *work overviews* and *biographies*, as well as *scholarly articles*.
