Membership

The Honor Council will consist of voting members comprised of faculty and student representatives, with a designee from Academic Affairs presiding as the non-voting Chair. The voting members will consist of one faculty member from each college and representatives assigned to the Honor Council through the Student Government Association. Faculty members shall serve for three years and shall be eligible for reappointment after one year has passed since their previous appointment.

Function

The Council conducts hearings when an allegation is made that a student has violated the Lander University Honor Code.
