Membership

The membership of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee shall consist of the dean of the College of Science and Mathematics, who will serve as chair; a doctor of veterinary medicine; a practicing faculty scientist; a fulltime employee who is not involved in animal research; and a community member. Members serve three years terms and are eligible for reappointment.

Function

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee is charged with reviewing and approving all proposed uses of live vertebrate animals in teaching and research.

Procedures

The Committee meets periodically at the call of its Chair to perform its function as stated above.

The Committee reports to the *VP of Academic Affairs*.
