Membership

The membership of the Institutional Review Board shall consist of one member from each of the following academic programs: Management, Nursing, Physical Education and Exercise Science, Psychology, and Sociology, and one member from the community. Members serve three-year terms and are eligible for reappointment.

Function

The purpose of the Institutional Review Board is to review applications for proposed human subjects research and to determine adherence to the guidelines for ethical research. The committee operates in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations for research with human subjects.

Procedures

The Committee meets periodically at the call of its Chair to perform its function as stated above.

The Committee reports to the VP of Academic Affairs.
