President's Grants Committee (2022-2023)

Appointed By: Provost and VPAA

Reports To Faculty Senate, Provost, and President

Membership:

The President's Grants Committee shall consist of members of the Faculty Senate Grants Committee who shall count as representatives of their College/Schools; enough at-large faculty members appointed by the Provost/VPAA to ensure that four of the six Colleges /Schools are represented on the Committee; and the Lander Grants Coordinator who shall serve as an ex-officio member. No faculty member may serve more than three consecutive years. The Chair of the Faculty Senate Grants Committee shall serve as the Chair of the President's Grants Committee. The Chair may not submit a President's Grant application while serving in that capacity.

Function:

The Committee reviews applications for President's Grants, ranks them according to their merit in compliance with pertaining guidelines, and, through the Provost/VPAA, makes recommendations to the President on the funding for submitted applications.
