Function

The committee serves in an advisory capacity for the directors in the areas of student activities, student organizations and recreational sports/intramurals. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, developing policies and procedures, acting as judicial body for organizational policy violations; and making recommendations to appropriate committees for the improvement of Lander University's co-curricular programs. Additionally, the committee selects nominees for Who's Who, Student Life Award winners and others as requested.
