Membership

The Fine Arts and Lectureship Committee will consist of four senators (no college or school may have more than one representative on the committee) and a representative from the Office of Academic Affairs (who will be appointed by the provost and vice president for academic affairs). The chair of the committee will be elected from its members during its first meeting of the academic year.

Functions

The Fine Arts and Lectureship Committee will review proposed events and will determine which events meet the requirements for Fine Arts and Lectureship credit. This committee will also recommend changes in the Fine Arts Lectureship Policy to the Faculty Senate. NOTE: The first two functions are handled through the Office of Academic Affairs between May 15 and August 15.

Procedure

Faculty sponsors who are seeking approval for a FALS event will complete an on-line application form which will be sent directly to the Chair of the committee. The Chair will forward an electronic copy of the application to all committee members. Within two Lander academic calendar days of receipt of a form, the other four members of the Committee will notify the Chair whether the event is acceptable. All five members of the Committee will vote. A decision to approve or to deny an application requires three votes. The Chair will forward the final decision of approval or denial and a copy of the application form to the Office of Academic Affairs.
