Membership

The Study Abroad Program Committee shall consist of the director of the Study Abroad Program, who will serve as chair; one faculty member from each college/school; one alternate from each college/school; the director of the Honors College; a representative from the Office of International Programs; the vice president of enrollment and access management; and two students who have participated in a Study Abroad experience. Faculty members will serve three-year terms, with reappointment possible. Students will serve one-year terms, with reappointment possible.

Function

The Study Abroad Program Committee shall advise the director of the Study Abroad Program on all matters concerning the program, including, but not limited to, requirements for participating in the program.

Procedures

The committee shall meet at least one time each semester. The committee shall report to the chief academic officer.
