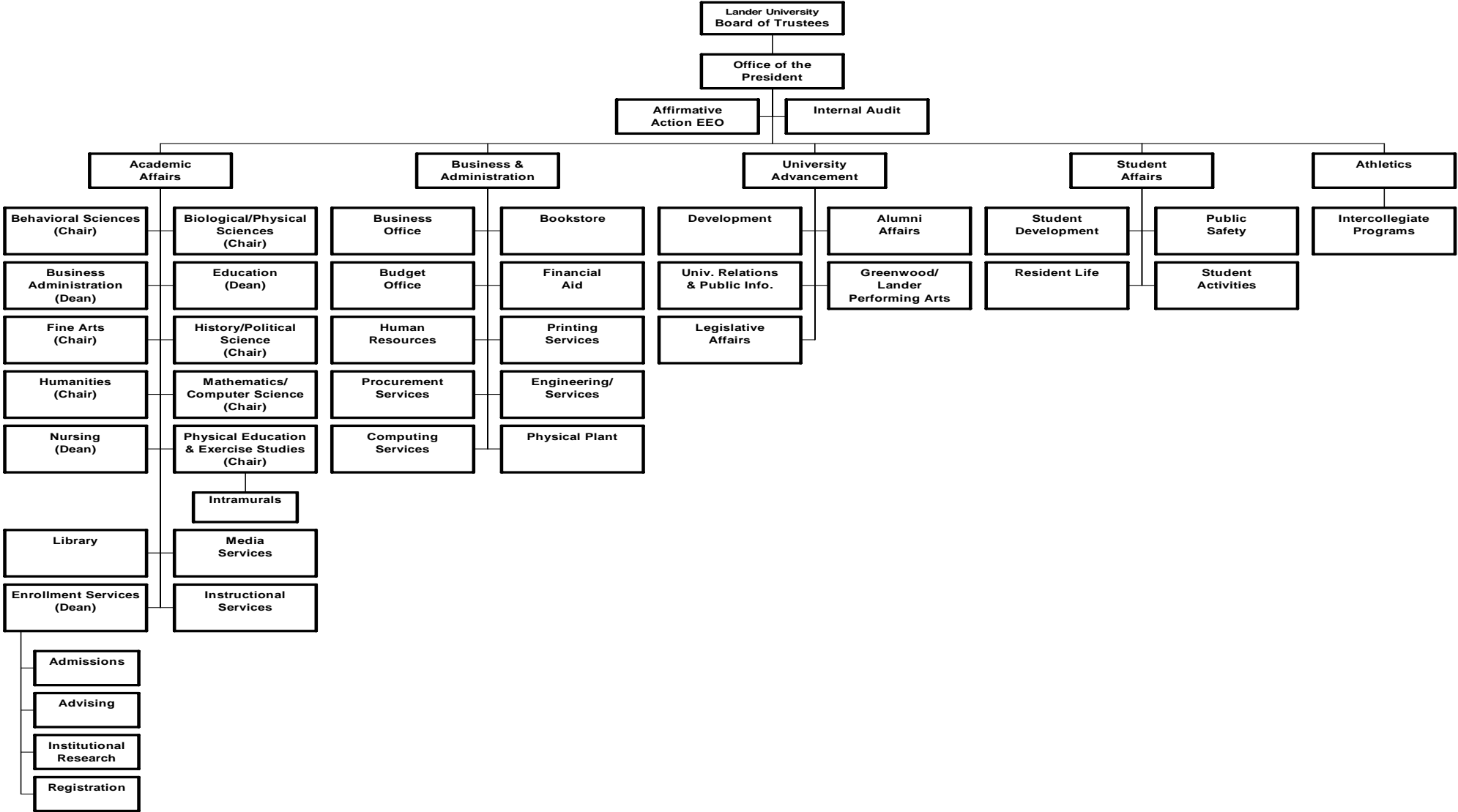

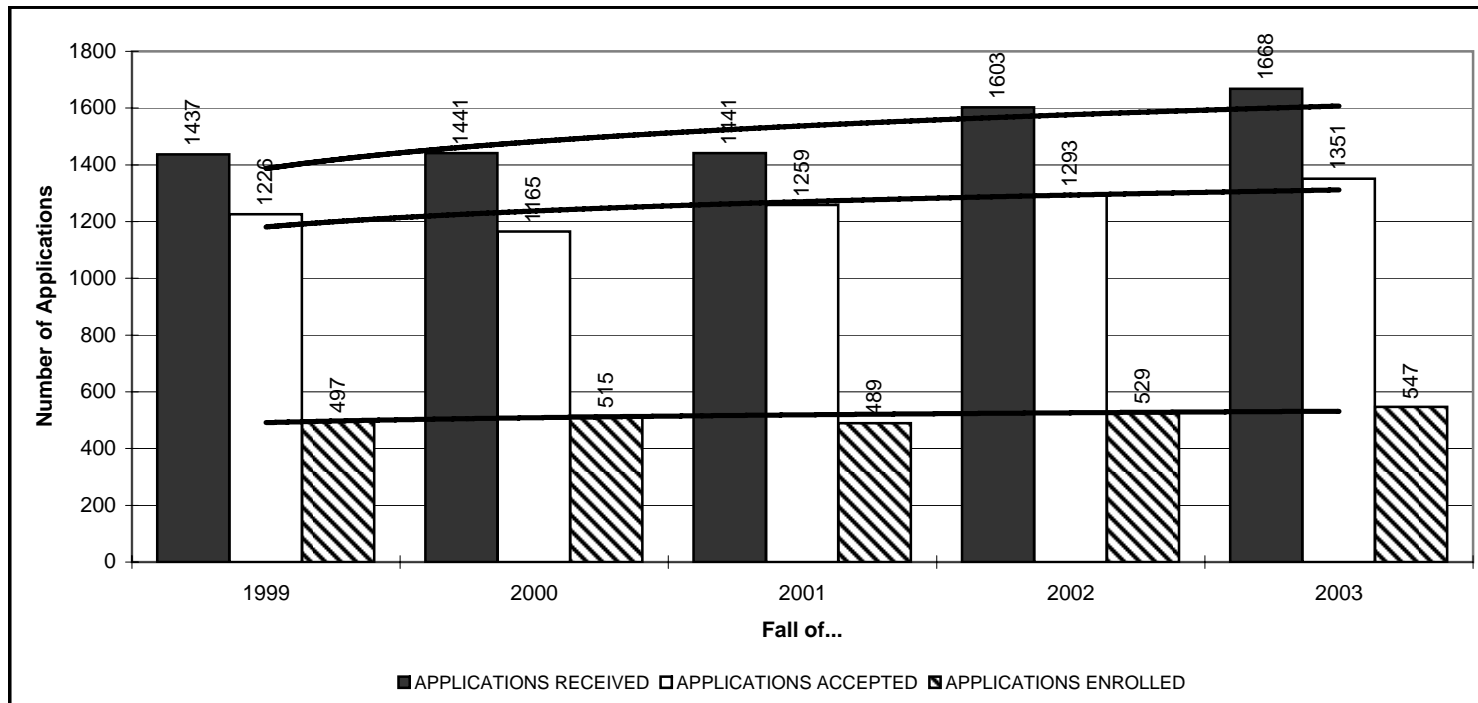

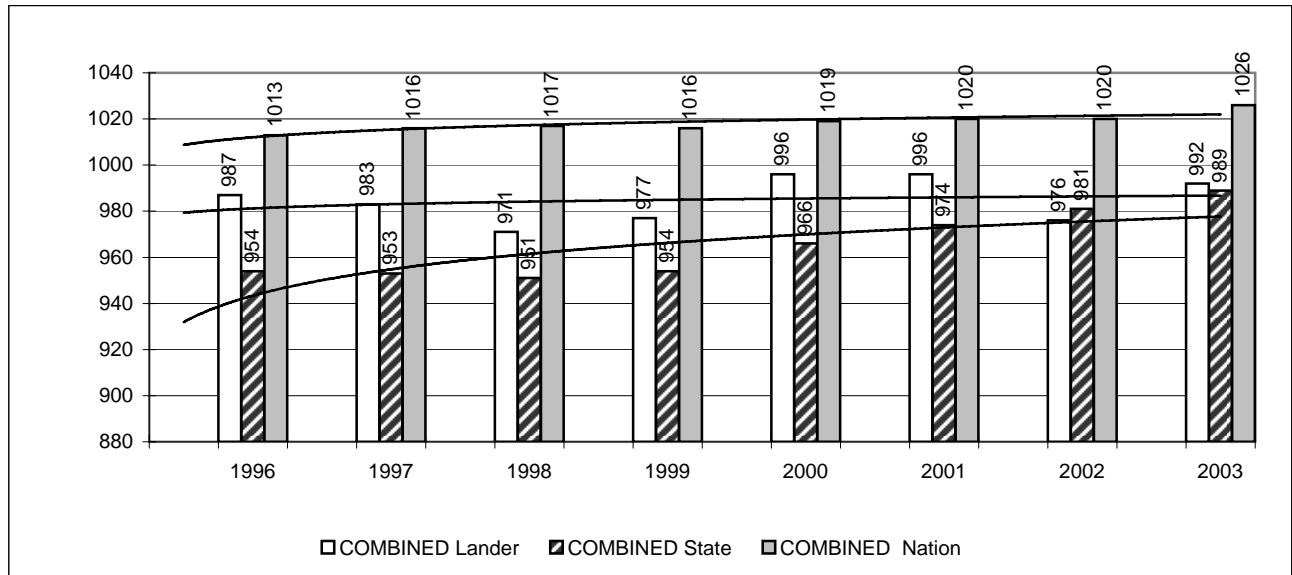

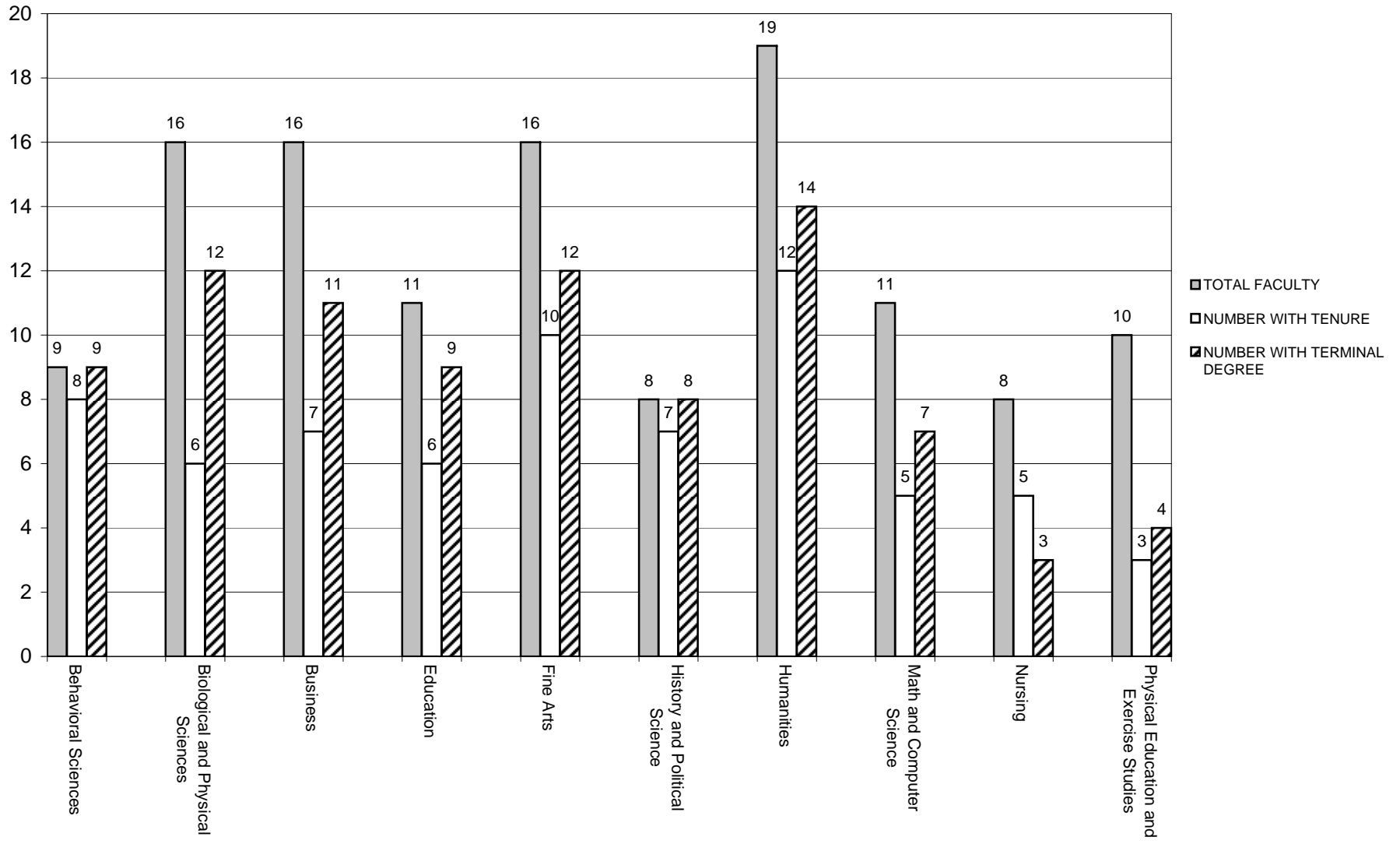

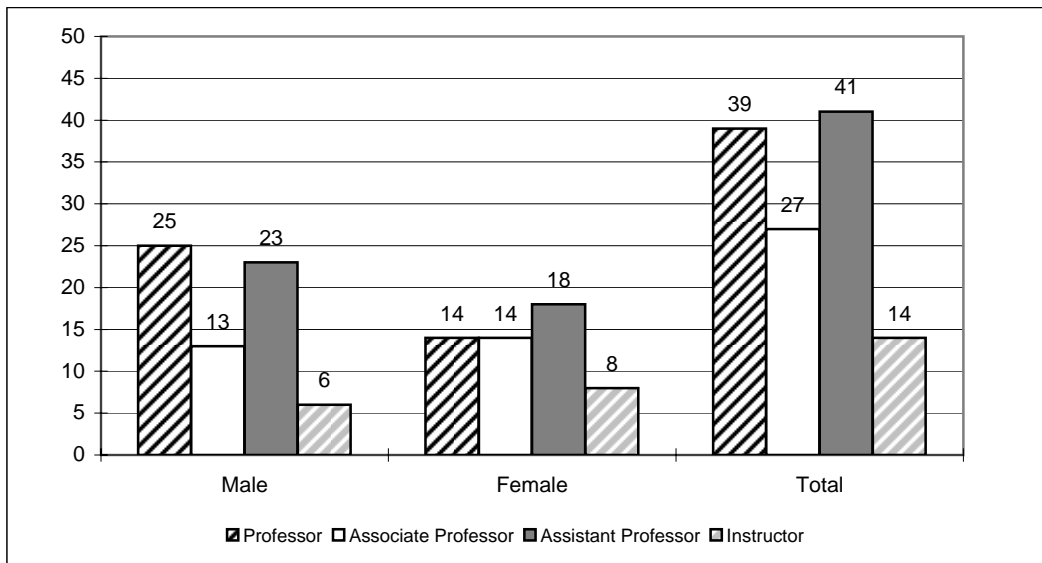
Faculty Headcount by Division/School by Tenure Status and Terminal Degree Fall 2003

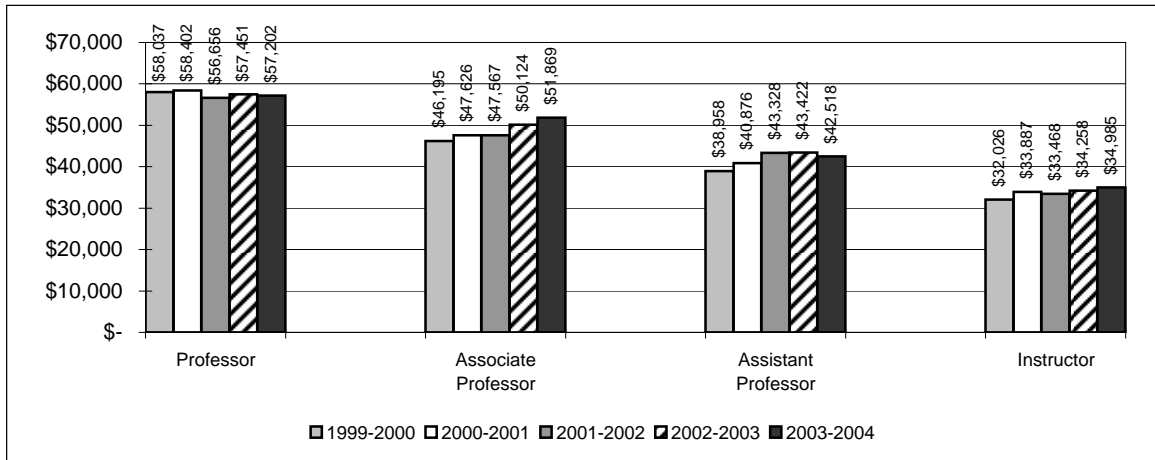
