

Auxiliary Fee:

The Auxiliary Fee funds targeted improvements to campus facilities, amenities, and technology that enhance where students live, learn, and connect. This includes upgrades to student spaces, dining and retail options, recreation areas, and academic equipment. By supporting these enhancements through a dedicated fee, the university can improve the student experience without increasing tuition.

Comprehensive Fee

The Comprehensive Fee covers a variety of general services and resources that support the overall student experience. These services include athletic resources, student health services, campus transportation, campus safety and security efforts, student events and activities, educational and technology resources and support, career and employment services, library services, fitness and recreation facilities, etc. By consolidating these services into one fee, it simplifies billing while ensuring consistent support for the overall student experience.

Bearcat Bundle Fee:

The Bearcat Bundle Fee provides all required textbooks and course materials to undergraduate students by the first day of class at a reduced, flat rate each semester. This program simplifies the purchasing process, lowers overall costs, and ensures students are prepared for academic success from day one, with the option to opt out each term.
