Assistant Teaching Professor of Music

The Position: The Department of Music at Lander University seeks applicants for a full-time, nontenure-track position as Assistant Teaching Professor of Music, beginning August 15, 2023. We seek candidates to teach our music history sequence for majors, general education courses with broad appeal (“History of Rock ‘n’ Roll” and similar courses), and applied lessons in voice, percussion, piano, or wind instruments. The candidate will also actively engage in departmental, institutional, and professional service, student advising, and professional development.

We seek a dynamic faculty member with a commitment to teaching excellence who can help recruit students to our music programs and offer stimulating general education courses for non-majors.

Requirements: Applicants must have earned a terminal degree in music history, voice, percussion, piano, or wind instrument by the time of appointment. The ideal candidate will be a skilled teacher of undergraduates with the ability to engage students in a variety of learning environments. We also seek someone who is actively pursuing professional development; eager to engage in departmental, institutional, and professional service; and able to work collaboratively in a small department. Previous teaching experience at the college level is required.
