

Criminology Faculty Positions – Rank Open Lander University

Preferences include experience in teaching both face-to-face and online courses in Criminology, the ability to teach research methods, and/or significant criminal justice and supervisory experience. The candidate should be committed to teaching excellence; willing to contribute to collaborative efforts in advising, recruitment, retention, and departmental growth; and work effectively with a diverse student population.

Responsibilities include teaching introductory and upper-level undergraduate CRIM courses in multiple modalities and the ability to contribute to Lander's M.S. in Criminology and Criminal Justice.
