Minimum Requirements: Bachelor's degree is required. Experience as a coach or collegiate runner. A valid driver's license and safe driving history are required. Must have strong skills in providing excellent customer service and demonstrate strong ethics.

Preferred Requirements: Master's degree preferred but not required.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge and understanding of coaching, recruiting and program administration required. Knowledge of NCAA rules and regulations required. Thorough knowledge of all aspects of the sport of cross country and track required.
