

ASSISTANT ATHLETIC TRAINER

Description: The Assistant Athletic Trainer will report directly to the Senior Associate Athletic/Director for Sports Medicine and will work within the framework of the Lander University Sports Medicine team which includes: 6 ATCs, 2 team physicians, 1 team orthopedic surgeon, 3 physical therapists, Lander University Counseling team, and 1 team dentist. These positions assist in the daily operation of the 2 Athletic Training Facilities. Sport coverage will be determined based on skillset of the candidate as well as overall composition of the Sports Medicine team

Minimum Requirements: A bachelor's of Arts or Science in Athletic training. Must be NATABOC certified and eligible for State of South Carolina licensure. Professional rescuer CPR/AED certification. A valid driver's license and safe driving history are required. Must have strong skills in providing excellent customer service and demonstrate strong.

Preferred Requirements: Master's degree preferred. Demonstrated experience in intercollegiate athletics, particularly in injury prevention and rehabilitation. Advanced rehabilitation techniques such as: Graston, FMS, active release therapy, or other manual or IASTM methods.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Ability to work as a member of a sports medicine team. Must have understanding of current athletic training techniques in regards to the recognition, treatment, and rehabilitation of athletic injuries. Experience working with a variety of sports is beneficial. Experience working as a member of a comprehensive sports medicine team is crucial. Knowledge of NCAA rules and regulations required.
