Lecturer of English

The Position: The Department of English and Foreign Languages at Lander University invites candidates to apply for a Lecturer of English position to begin August 2023. The department seeks candidates skilled at teaching first-year composition. Opportunities to teach courses other than composition may be available, depending upon departmental need and the candidate's qualifications. While not tenure-track, the position does include the opportunity for promotion.

The Department: The Department of English and Foreign Languages offers degrees in English; English, Professional Writing; English, Secondary Teacher Certification; Spanish; and Humanities. We expect to offer an emphasis in Creative Writing beginning next year. Our two-course composition sequence and introduction to literature and survey courses serve the general education curriculum.

Requirements: Applicants must have earned an M.A. or M.F.A. degree in English, Creative Writing, or a related discipline by the time of appointment. The ideal candidate will be a skilled teacher of undergraduates who is also eager to engage in departmental and institutional service and able to work collaboratively in a close-knit department.

Application: Candidates should submit a cover letter explaining their qualifications and interest in the position, a current CV that includes contact information for at least three references, and evidence of effective teaching.
