Preferred Qualifications Doctorate (Ph.D., Ed.D.) in Early Childhood, Curriculum and Instruction, or other education related field. Experience teaching at the university level. Experience with supervision of teacher candidates. Demonstrated potential for scholarly productivity. Familiarity with CAEP standards and accreditation processes.
