Assistant Professor of Management, College of Business and Technology.

**The Position:** The College of Business (COB) invites qualified candidates to apply for a tenure track Assistant Professor of Management to start in August 2026.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Applicants must have, at a minimum, a master's degree in a Business field. Candidates holding or pursuing a Ph.D. are preferred. Candidates with less than an earned Ph.D. will be hired with Lecturer status and will be converted to Assistant Professor status upon completion of the degree.

**Knowledge/Skills/Ability:** We seek candidates with broad expertise in general business and management. Preferred candidates will be able to teach a combination of introductory business coursework, upper-level undergraduate management coursework, and graduate-level management coursework. Preferred candidates will have expertise in supply chain management and/or entrepreneurship. Preferred candidates will hold the required teaching credentials but also have significant industry experience. Qualified candidates will have excellent communication skills and the ability to work cooperatively with colleagues in a collegial campus community. Candidates will engage and advise a diverse student population.

**Faculty Responsibilities:** This position carries responsibilities in teaching, scholarship, and service, as well as student advising. Faculty members typically teach four sections per semester, advise students, serve on university and college committees, and engage in professional development activities. Teaching assignments will align with the qualifications of the individual and the needs of the college. Candidates must be willing and qualified to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in business and related fields including management and entrepreneurship in both traditional and online settings. Candidates must be willing to serve, as assigned, on both COBT committees and Lander University committees. According to AACSB engagement and impact guidelines, School of Business faculty engage with the local community according to their professional area of expertise. This position requires the academic advising of students. Assistant/Associate professor candidates must demonstrate the potential or ability to conduct scholarly research of sufficient quality and quantity to satisfy School of Business guidelines for AACSB Scholarly Academic (SA) qualification. Lecturer candidates must demonstrate professional experience and engagement to satisfy the School of Business guidelines for AACSB Instructional Practitioner (IP) qualifications.

**Salary:** Salary commensurate with education and experience.

**The College:** The College of Business and Technology consists of the School of Business, Department of Media and Design, and Department of Applied Computing. The School of Business offers bachelor's degrees in Accounting, Financial Services, Management, Marketing, and Entrepreneurship as well as an MBA and MS in Management.
