

University Supervisors of Student Teacher Candidates

The College of Education invites applications for University Supervisor positions. University Supervisors observe and evaluate teacher candidates during the semester-long student teaching experience.

University Supervisors must be a certified teacher evaluator in the state of South Carolina “Expanded ADEPT 4.0” teacher effectiveness assessment system. The College of Education will provide Expanded ADEPT 4.0 training at no cost for those selected to serve as university supervisors who are not already certified. Student teacher supervisors are compensated on a per teacher candidate basis. Some travel costs are reimbursed.

Minimum Qualifications: Master’s degree with a minimum of 18 graduate semester hours of coursework in the teaching related activities is required. Prior PK-12 experience required; university teaching experience preferred.
