CRIM Category #2: Choose 3 hours from the following: LEG 308 or POLS 308, LEG 311 or POLS 311, LEG 312 or POLS 312, LEG 313 or POLS 313, POLS 318, POLS 325, POLS 386, POLS 391, or POLS 445

CRIM Category #3: Choose 3 hours from the following: SOCI 317, SOCI 328, or SOCI 399

CRIM Category #4: Choose 3 hours of a CRIM courses at 200-level or above and 6 hours from CRIM courses at 300-level or above. Courses in Category #4 cannot already be used for the major's Core requirements or for CRIM Category #1
