Paralegal Studies Area Requirements:

Law (select any 9 credit hours): LEG 311, LEG 312, LEG 313, LEG 366, or LEG 371

Technical Writing (select 3 credit hours): ENGL 350, WRIT 373, WRIT 450

Additional requirements: 12 hrs. of LEG courses from an Associate's degree program in Paralegal Studies: Introduction to Law & Ethics, Legal Writing, Legal Bibliography/ Research, and one more LEG course at the 100- or 200-level

Admissions requirements: 12 hrs. of LEG coursework from a technical college. An Associate's Degree in Paralegal Studies is preferred, but not required.

Students can transfer up to 64 hrs. of coursework into Lander from a technical college.

Students must earn a "C" or better for coursework to be transferred into Lander.
