Complete BFA Review and maintain at least a 2.3 GPA in art courses to graduate with a major in Fine Art.

General Education

A student must take courses from two different disciplines in the following General Education categories: Behavioral and Social Perspectives; Humanities and Fine Arts; and Scientific and Mathematical Reasoning.

Optional, but Recommended:

Study Abroad Courses (ART 352 & ART 372). ART 352 & ART 372 will each count once towards the B.F.A. degree.
