Course Information:

Coursework includes 76 semester hours of major program requirements.

Coursework must include at least 30 hours earned in 300 or above level courses, of which 12 hours must be in the major

GPA/Grade Req:

"C" or better in 100-level art courses before proceeding to sophomore studio courses and ENGL 101 and ENGL 102.

General Education:

A student must take courses in two different disciplines in the following General Education categories: Behavioral and Social Perspectives; Humanities and Fine Arts; and Scientific and Mathematical Reasoning.

Optional, but Recommended:

Summer Study Abroad Courses (ART 352 and ART 372). ART 353 and ART 372 will each count once towards the B.F.A. degree.
