Required Composite Score: 464 or Higher

A candidate may also meet the program admission assessment requirement by achieving a composite score of 464 on the three subtests, with no individual subtest score more than four points below the required passing score for that subtest.

In order to be eligible for the composite option, you must take the newest Math (5733).
