#### **Recommendation:**

#### If you chose mostly: (in NONE or in few of my assignments)

If your experience and confidence levels were rated lower, then English 190 would BE BENEFICIAL for you. There is no assigned coursework, but the class helps explain and work on current writing assignments. *Consider registering for this course*.

### If you chose mostly: (in SOME of my assignments)

If your experience and confidence levels rated in the middle range, then you may WANT TO CONSIDER English 190. College writing assignments are different than high school assignments, and the class is built to fill in the gap between those. *If interested, consider registering for this course.* 

## If you chose mostly: (in ALL of my assignments)

If your experience and confidence levels rated in the higher range, then you may not require English 190. However, keep in mind that academic writing in university courses is different than high school.
