FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



ARE ALL MY REQUIRED COURSES OFFERED ONLINE?

Yes, all your required courses can be completed in a purely online format. However, there are courses offered that also occasionally incorporate live lecture with the ability to attend remotely via the internet. For our Paralegal students, these classes are typically taught in person at the University Center in Greenville in the evening and broadcast statewide for remote students. These hybrid class offerings allow a mix of purely online and a traditional lecture-type class.

CAN I ADD A MINOR TO MY B.S. IN PARALEGAL STUDIES?

Yes you can! Many paralegal students can complete the required hours for a minor, notably in Political Science, without adding additional course hours with wise use of the allowed electives.

ARE THERE OTHER LANDER ORGANIZATIONS OR GROUPS THAT I SHOULD CONSIDER?

If you are interested in applying for law school, we strongly recommend talking with your advisor and working with **Lander's Pre-Law Advisement Center** to properly plan and prepare for law school admission requirements. The Pre-Law Advisement Center will be your Lander information hub to guide you in connection with law school admissions.

I HAVE CREDITS AT MY COLLEGE OR ANOTHER INSTITUTION THAT ARE OUTSIDE OF THE PARALEGAL PROGRAM PLAN. WILL THOSE HOURS BE ACCEPTED FOR TRANSFER?

You can transfer up to 90 credit hours to Lander, so those classes will also be accepted. However, you will still be required to meet the degree requirements in terms of required classes and 300-level or above level classes.

AS AN ONLINE STUDENT, HOW WILL I KNOW HOW TO NAVIGATE AND WHO TO ASK FOR ASSISTANCE AT LANDER?

To help with the transition to Lander, all incoming online students are assisted by Lander's Academic Transfer Coordinator to ensure proper guidance through admissions, financial aid, and academic advising. Each student will also be assigned an academic advisor from their program to provide detailed information about academic requirements and help with academic matters through graduation.

I CAN TAKE ADDITIONAL COURSES AS I COMPLETE MY ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE. WHICH COURSES WOULD MOST BENEFIT ME TRANSFERRING TO LANDER?

If possible, take a lab science course at your technical college. While Lander offers online lab science courses, they can be the type of course that students find more accessible in a traditional classroom setting. Secondly, take PSC 201: American Government as POLS 101R (Lander's version of the same course) since it can be a Social Sciences course at your technical college and is a prerequisite for more coursework at Lander.
