



Lander University Outdoor Pool Policy for Faculty/Staff/Students – Summer

Purpose: The Lander University Outdoor Pool is available for faculty, staff, and students to enjoy during the summer months. This policy outlines the guidelines for safe and responsible use of the facility.

Operating Hours:

- Monday – Wednesday: 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM
- Hours are subject to change based on weather conditions and maintenance needs.

Lifeguard and Safety Notice:

- No certified lifeguard is on duty.
- All people using the pool do so at their own risk.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- Swimming alone is strictly prohibited.

Admission Policy:

- Faculty/Staff Members/Students: May purchase a one-time Summer Pool Pass for \$5. Passes must be shown upon entry.
- Guests: Must be accompanied by a Faculty/Staff member or Student. Admission is \$5 per guest per day.
- Only Acceptable payment is via Credit or Debit Card.
- Faculty/Staff/Students are allowed to bring up to 3 guests.

Rules and Conduct:

- **Proper swimwear is required.**
- No diving, horseplay, or running in the pool area.
- All users must shower before entering the pool.

- Management reserves the right to remove any individual for behavior that is unsafe or disruptive.
- Glass containers, alcohol, tobacco products, and vaping devices are not allowed within the pool area.
- Food and beverages must be kept in designated areas; no food is allowed in the water.
- Personal flotation devices must be U.S. Coast Guard-approved.
- Campus Recreation Employees on duty have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations.
- Failure to comply with pool policies may result in removal from the facility and potential suspension of pool privileges.

Liability Waiver:

- By using the facility, all patrons acknowledge and accept that:
- They are responsible for their own safety.
- The facility, institution, or management is not liable for injuries, accidents, or loss of property.

Safety and Health Regulations:

- Faculty, staff, and students are encouraged to shower before entering the pool.
- Individuals with open wounds, skin infections, or communicable diseases should not enter the pool.
- In case of an emergency, notify pool staff immediately.
- There will be a Lander Campus Recreation Employee Staffed during all hours of operation.

Special Events and Closures:

- The pool may be reserved for university-sponsored events, which will be communicated in advance. (i.e. Orientation, Open House, etc.)
- Temporary closures may occur due to inclement weather or maintenance needs.
