What to Bring

- Pillows
- Extra-long twin sheets and blankets/comforter
- Towels and bath mat
- Shower tote/caddy
- Toiletries and first aid items
- Shower curtain, liner, and rings
- Toilet paper
- Cleaning Supplies:
- Vacuum cleaner, broom, mop, etc.
- Cleaning wipes or spray
- Trash cans with trash bags
- Laundry detergent and dryer sheets/balls
- Fabric softener and stain remover
- Laundry basket/bag/hangers

Approved Appliances Based on Residence Hall

Non-Kitchen Areas (Brookside, Centennial, Chipley, New Hall, Thomason, Williamston)

- Microwave ovens (700-watt maximum power)
- Sealed-unit coffee makers (Keurig, electric kettles, etc.)
- Mini-fridges (must not exceed 1.2 amps)

Kitchen Areas (Bearcat Village, McGhee Court, Lide, University Place)

- Microwave ovens (700-watt maximum power)
- Appliances with unexposed heating elements (blenders, George Foreman Grills™, Panini presses, slow cookers, etc.)
- Sealed-unit coffee makers (Keurig, electric kettles, etc.)
- Mini-fridges (must not exceed 1.2 amps)

What NOT to Bring

- Multi-outlets without surge protection
- Extension Cords
- Candles, incense, or vape pens
- Gas/charcoal grills, toaster ovens, air fryers or deep fryers
- Halogen lamps
- String lights (unless battery operated)
- Knives/Firearms
- Alcohol/Drugs/Drug Paraphernalia
- Weights/Dumbbells
- TV mounting brackets/command strips
- Electrical Instruments
- Large furniture
