
Campus Parking Areas, Average Walk Times, and Color Codes of Permits

Faculty/Staff/Commuter (**FSC**) parking (highlighted in yellow) is located along the perimeter of the Lander University campus and is open to commuting students and employees with valid FSC-zoned parking permits. Reserved parking requires a reserved parking permit. Residential students should park in the zoned lot(s) indicated on their color-coded parking permit. Visitor parking is available in the Visitors Lot (VP) and FSC Lot #4. Handicapped parking is available in the Visitors Lot and FSC Lots #1, #4 and #5.

Parking permits, reserved parking and visitor parking permits are available through the Lander University Police Department (GE).



Helpful Hints and Important Information:

- Plan to arrive on campus 10-15 minutes early to allow time for finding a parking space and/or walking to academic and administrative buildings.
- Closer lots will have higher demand, especially in the mornings. To avoid this congestion, consider parking in an outer-perimeter lot.
- Zoned parking is enforced on Lander's campus between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday-Friday. Parking permits are required to park on campus during these hours. Vehicles must be parked in the zoned lot(s) indicated on the parking permit, which should be displayed on the vehicle's back windshield.
- A limited number of reserved spaces are available in various lots around campus. Contact the Lander University Police Department for information on purchasing a reserved space. Reserved parking is enforced Monday-Friday, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. Unauthorized vehicles in reserved spaces will be issued a parking citation for \$75.
- Visitor spaces are enforced between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday - Friday. After hours, these spaces are open for general parking; however, service and delivery spaces are not to be used for general parking at any time.
- · Handicapped parking is enforced at all times.
