GPA/Grade Req:

Earn "C" or better in 100-level art courses before proceeding to the sophomore studio courses. Students in Art Education must maintain a GPA of 2.75 in the teacher certification requirements and a 2.65 GPA overall.

General Education

Students must earn a "C" or better in all professional education and major program courses.

A student must take courses from two different disciplines in the following General Education categories: Behavioral and Social Perspectives; Humanities and Fine Arts; and Scientific and Mathematical Reasoning.
