**Overall first place winners of the Homecoming competition for the Blue and Gold divisions will win the Bearcat Cup and \$500 in programming funds to be used before the last day of classes of the spring 2022 semester!**

The Homecoming event forms are now **digital**. We have provided the links below within the document. Please make sure your forms are complete with all materials (to include but not limited to drawings, descriptions, and scripts) necessary when submitted.

**Late and/or incomplete forms without all documentation will not be accepted.**

Homecoming rules for each event, as well as general rules, are in the enclosed packet. All participants are responsible for reading and abiding by all rules. The Department of Student Life reserves the right to make any changes to the rules or this document at any time before, after, or during Homecoming week. **General Guidelines**

1. All Homecoming communication will be directed to the person of contact for your organization or group. That representative must contact Homecoming Committee by email ([homecoming@lander.edu](mailto:homecoming@lander.edu)) or by phone (864-388-8244).
2. All students are welcomed and encouraged to create teams to enter the competition, regardless of the organization affiliation.
3. A student may be listed on multiple rosters. If a student tries to check in for a team and is not listed on the roster, their points will not be counted toward the event attendance.
4. If organizations or groups choose to register as a team, they will not be separated from any events to compete individually.
5. Organizations or groups may not enter as multiple teams in competitive events.

6. Organizations may partner to create a single team, but equal representation from each group must be participating in each pointed event.
7. When a question arises regarding rules, the authority first goes to the Homecoming committee, then to the Director of Student Life or their designee. If the question arises regarding the overall competition, the authority will then go to the Director of Student Life or their designee. Decisions made by the Director of Student Life or their designee are considered final.
8. Masks should be worn during all events unless an exception is provided on the day of the event by the Director of Student Life. All COVID-19 guidelines are in place as issued by the state and local governments and Lander University and should be followed by all organizations.
9. Organizations or groups that are participating with 1 to 35 members will be classified in the **Blue Division**.
10. Organizations or groups that are participating with 36 members or above will be classified in the **Gold Division**.

  - a. You must provide: an explanation of the skit, song lyrics, and the script.
    - A digital file with the music (All music should be edited prior! The team may receive a deduction of 10 points if the Homecoming committee ask for **more than one** edit of the music.)
    - A list of props for rehearsal and description of the costumes.
  - b. All team members participating in the showcase must be in full dress attire and must bring all props/materials they plan to use. All members in the talent portion must be in attendance for their rehearsal time on October 24, 2021. [Sign up here for a time!](#)
5. It's the Great Pumpkin Carving Contest
  - a. Description and drawing must be submitted by Friday, October 15, 2021 by 3:00 pm via the entry form. Please use this example ([pumpkin form](#)), design, scan, and submit with your entry form.

  - a. September 22, 2021 in CC 250 from 5:30 pm-6:30 pm

### **Form Submission Details**

- The Event Entry form link is on page 3. Please review the packet for specific instructions regarding any additional information needed.
- King and Queen Entry forms links are on page 6. These must be turned in by the contestant in order to schedule their interview appointment by the date on page 6.
- If any Lander-funded group's purpose is in direct conflict with any night's event, they are allowed to participate exhibition-style.
- Students, faculty, and staff must have a valid Lander ID to participate in Homecoming events.

## **Sponsor a King and Queen Candidate**

### **\*Student recognized organization or student groups only\***

An organization/team may sponsor one student for Queen and one student for King. Multiple organizations or groups may not sponsor the same candidate. Due to scheduling of interviews and pictures, the king and queen candidates must turn in their own forms.

The sponsoring organization/team must participate in a **minimum of five events** in order to sponsor a candidate.

Each candidate must have completed 24 credited hours at Lander prior to the fall of 2021 semester and have a Lander cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above. Candidates must be a full-time Lander University student (currently carrying at least 12 semester hours). Candidates must not be on academic or disciplinary probation.

There is no fee for organizations to sponsor a King or Queen candidate. Each group will be awarded five points if they sponsor a king contestant and five points if they sponsor a queen contestant.

King and Queen Candidates are highly encouraged to attend all pointed and non-pointed events.

Popularity vote (100 points) and an interview process (100 points) will select the Homecoming King and Queen. All nominees will be recognized prior to Homecoming day, and the winners will be announced on Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> following the Men's Soccer game v. Flagler. If two or more candidates tie for the overall scoring of King, Queen, or any runner up, the highest interview score will break the tie. In the event the interview scores are the same, the highest GPA will break the tie.

Students are encouraged to campaign to the student body. Candidates may use social media, videos, approved flyers and posters to spread the message of their nomination for Homecoming King or Queen. ALL FLYERS/POSTERS must be stamped by our office between 10:00 am-10:30 pm from a student worker in the Bearcat Lounge. Please review the posting policy. **If posters/flyers are posted in inappropriate places, the individual's posters/flyers will be removed and the student may receive a point deduction or the candidate being disqualified.** If there are any marketing materials that are in violation of University policy, this may result in point deduction from the candidate or being disqualified. Candidates may not campaign using food or drink items.

If there is inclement weather, please make sure to review all emails in case of any specific changes. Candidates will be expected to comply.

### **HOMECOMING PARTICIPATION POINTS (All Week Monday-Friday)**

#### **\*Pointed event\***

- Teams have a chance to gain extra points by attending campus wide Homecoming events. To gain participation points:
  - Gold Division: a minimum 25% of a team's roster must be in attendance for 20 additional points
  - Blue Division: a minimum 50% of the team's roster must be in attendance for 20 additional points
  - QR codes will be posted at events for members to scan and fill out a digital form to count their attendance. The names submitted per event will be compared to the original and previously submitted roster. Only members on the team roster may be counted for participation points.

### **MEDALLION GHOST HUNT-All Week (Monday-Friday)**

#### **\*Pointed event\***

- One medallion will be hidden at on/off campus facilities that are related to Lander University. Clues to where the medallion is hidden will be released on @lu\_studentlife Instagram each day. Participants must return the medallion to the Department of Student Life to receive points for that day. One found medallion will equal 10 points.

### **Medallion Guidelines**

- All participants are expected to follow and comply with all guidelines, policies, procedures set by the University, the Director of Student Life (or their designee) and by the Homecoming Committee.
- All participants are expected to respect other groups and organizations participating; as well as any staff or students participating as members of the Homecoming Committee.
- When searching for a medallion, participants should not invade the privacy of any campus community member (students, faculty, or staff).
- There will NOT be a medallion hidden in or around an office space. Any participant that violates this policy of going into specific office spaces will result in an automatic 20-point reduction, possible removal of the individual(s) involved and may result in disqualification.
- Participants should refrain from camping out and waiting for the medallion to be hidden. This includes, but not limited to following staff or committee members. Please wait for the clue to be dropped. There will be a medallion for each division to find (one for Blue and one for Gold).

SERVICE PROJECT: The Homeless Period Project Donations (Tuesday-Thursday)

**\*Pointed event\***

- Teams participating in Homecoming will have the opportunity to gain additional points by donating money to the Homeless Period Project. The Homeless Period Project mission is to *provide menstrual hygiene products to those in need while educating and advocating to end the stigma of menstruation.* (<https://www.homelessperiodproject.org/>).

  - Teams can ask others (faculty, staff, students) to make a donation and include their organization name they are using for Homecoming to assist with their numbers.
  - The point breakdown is below.
  - The link will open Tuesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am and close at 8:00 pm Thursday, October 28<sup>th</sup>! Winners will be announced during the Homecoming Winner announcement on Saturday following the Soccer game.
    - Point Breakdown:
      - Over \$500.00 = 100 points (max)
      - \$250.00-499.99= 75 points
      - \$100.00-249.00= 50 points
      - \$25.00-99.99= 25 points
      - \$1.00-\$24.99= 5 points
  - Organizations may not bribe anyone to submit donations. Organizations may not demand or require members of groups to contribute or donate.

DRESS REHEARSAL (10/24/2021) IS REQUIRED for the Showcase! Sign up for a dress rehearsal time by Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm! The rehearsal will be in the PEES Gym.

Turn in the explanation of skit, song lyrics, script, list of props for rehearsal, and description of costumes with entry form no later than **3:00 pm on Friday, October 15th, 2021.**

- All groups should pre-record scripts.
- Music and/or video materials must be in a digital file. The digital file should contain only the songs you are using, in the correct order of your performance.
- All music and recordings must be appropriate, no explicit language, etc. and will be approved by the Department of Student Life by 10/15/21, with a resubmission due by 10/22/21. Groups may lose points if resubmission occurs more than one time. You must submit the file to the entry form. If any issues arise, please email [homecoming@lander.edu](mailto:homecoming@lander.edu)
- Groups participating in the Showcase will sign up for a dress rehearsal time when they turn in their entry form. All participants must attend dress rehearsal on **Sunday, October 24<sup>th</sup>**. Failure to participate in the dress rehearsal will disqualify your organization from the Showcase. Athletic or flat bottom shoes should be worn by all participants. **High heels are not allowed on the gym floor. YOU MUST BRING ALL PROPS AND BE DRESSED AS YOU WOULD FOR THE PERFORMANCE DURING REHEARSAL.** Any items that were not previously shown during rehearsal may result in a 10-point deduction.

- All participants in the Showcase must be members of your organization/group.
- Each group is responsible for its own props. **Do not use any type of prop/product that would leave any residue or debris on the floor** (including but not limited to glitter, body glitter, powder, etc.) Clear the floor completely once your performance is over. Point deductions may occur if groups do not follow instructions. If you have any questions, please contact Dr. Demario Watts directly at [dwatts@lander.edu](mailto:dwatts@lander.edu).
- Time limit – The maximum time allowed for set-up, performance and tear down/clean up should **not exceed 8 minutes**. However, there is no minimum time limit.
