GPA/Grade Req.: Students must earn a "C" or better in 100-level art courses before proceeding to the sophomore studio courses and also maintain at least a 2.3 GPA in art courses in order to graduate with a major in Fine Art. Students will complete a BFA Candidacy Review at the end of the sophomore year and a BFA Review at the end of their final semester.

Optional, but Recommended: Summer Study Abroad Courses (ART 352 & ART 372). ART 352 & ART 372 will each count once towards the B.F.A. degree.
