

Art Alliance at Lander University Constitution

Article I—Name

Section 1 The name of this organization shall be the Art Alliance at Lander University.

Article II—Purpose

Section 1 It shall be the purpose of this organization to meet together to further the “art” experience with our fellow peers of Lander University; whom which have a further interest in the arts as a group outside of our direct classes.

Article III—Affiliations

Section 1 This group of Art Alliance at Lander University is a group only established at Lander University.

Article IV—Membership

Section 1 Any person who becomes a member in this registered Lander student organization must have a consistent minimum of 7 full-time enrolled Lander students with a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Section 2 Additional eligibility requirements consist of 3 voluntary hours that help out in the “art community” around Lander University. All members (and officers) must be present at all official meeting times unless discussed otherwise. Voluntary hours must be decided upon by the members and sign-up sheets will be available throughout the semester for different opportunities.

Article V—Officers

Section 1 The officers of this organization shall consist of: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and leader of the Art Mentoring program for incoming freshman.

Section 2 All officers must be present at all official meeting times unless notified otherwise.

Treasurer: To keep track of all money brought in from voluntary opportunities, fundraisers and any other prospects that this organization may have.

Mentoring Leader: To guide the students, that are wanting to be mentored throughout their year for any additional help.

Article VI—Elections

- Section 1 Selection of officers shall be held yearly (August), unless an officer is graduating in the Fall terms, there will be another selection at the beginning of that new term (January.)
- Section 2 The officer that is already in position will move up in rank if they choose to. If not, there will be a poll for who would like to run and a vote will dictate who will become an officer. If there is more than one person running for office, two-thirds majority rule will decide who becomes the officer of the group.

Article VII—Meetings

- Section 1 Regular meetings of this organization shall be held monthly at differently discussed meeting times; for which everyone can agree upon.

Article VIII—Advisers

- Section 1 The faculty advisor of the Art Alliance at Lander University is Sandra Singletary.

Article V—Constitutional Amendments

- Section 1 The constitution may be amended by a vote of two-thirds majority
- Section 2 Roberts Rules of Order shall govern meetings of this organization
