

Baptist Collegiate Ministry at Lander University Guidelines

NAME

The name shall be The Baptist Collegiate Ministry at Lander University (BCM)

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the BCM shall be upon the basis of voluntary participation by college student aged adults.

PURPOSE

The purpose shall be to provide a ministry to individuals in the campus community that represent Jesus Christ.

LEADERSHIP

The leadership team consist of President, Missions, Community Missions Team, Outreach, Small groups/Discipleship, Freshman/New Students, Ministry/Prayer, Internationals, and Praise Band.

MEETINGS

The leadership team meets at least one a month at a convenient time for the majority of participants. The BCM will hold weekly meetings (worship services) during the school year. The President in consultation with the Collegiate Minister may call additional meetings of the leadership team as needed.

BUDGET

The necessary funding for the BCM shall be allocated by the South Carolina Baptist convention, supporting churches, Lakelands Baptist Association, and supporting individual contributions. No dues are required.

LEADERSHIP APPOINTMENTS

1. During the Spring Semester a Leadership Selection Committee composed of 3 to 6 members shall be named by the President in consultation with the Baptist Collegiate Minister with preference given to at least one representative per class. The President will serve as an officio member of the committee.
2. Students who wish to recommend someone for leadership may submit names on the appropriate nominating form. Those recommended (or nominated) may be asked to give more information. No additional written nominations will be accepted after the deadline.
3. The Leadership Selection Committee will then meet and review those persons nominated. The committee will give attention to those nominations submitted by BCM members; however, they will have the freedom to nominate additional persons. The Leadership Committee will give due consideration to those students that have willingly and faithfully served in BCM Ministries.

4. The Leadership Selection Committee will submit a list of leadership recommendations for affirmation during the latter part of Spring Semester.
5. Leadership of BCM will be trained for the remaining portion of the Spring Semester and summer and will assume their positions and will assume leadership in the Fall Semester.
6. Vacancies in leadership may be filled by the existing leadership team.

APPROVAL OF BCM ACTIVITIES

All programs, activities, and ministries of the BCM are subject to the approval of the South Carolina Baptist Convention, BCM Leadership Team and/or the Baptist Collegiate Minister.
