

LOGICS Organization

The Sociology Club has voted on a name change in Fall 2018 to reflect both Criminology and Sociology majors.

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE

LOGICS purpose is to provide a forum for both criminology and sociology majors and others to discuss sociological and criminological issues outside the classroom.

LOGICS will hold an average of one event on campus each month of each semester. Events will include, but not limited to: career development programs, media events, student and faculty socials, field trips and fundraising.

ARTICLE II: MEMBERSHIP

Membership in LOGICS will be open to any Lander University student who is or who is interested in becoming a Criminology or Sociology major, or who is simply interested in the fields of criminology and/or sociology.

Members are asked to actively be involved in LOGICS. All members should attend at least 75% of the organizational meetings and programs.

ARTICLE III: FINANCES

The advisor shall be in charge of all finance-related issues, subject to democratic majority vote on the part of the club. Dues will be \$10 per semester. The date in which the dues are due will be set by the organization.

LOGICS has three officers: President, Vice President, and Secretary. Officers will serve on an annual basis with elections being held during the Spring semester. There are no limits to years of service.

ARTICLE IV: LEADERSHIP

Executive Officers should attend all meetings. In the case of an emergency, Executive Officers should contact the Advisor and the other Executive Officers as soon as possible. If Executive Officers miss more than 3 meetings, they will be asked to step down from their position.

ARTICLE V: OPERATIONS

LOGICS shall meet approximately twice a month or as the club deems appropriate. Events will be held approximately every 4 – 6 weeks. These events include FALS event, club socials, and volunteer opportunities. Administration of the meetings will adhere to guidelines as described in the ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER.

ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS

A minimum of even club members are necessary to change or add any Bylaws in this constitution, as well as two of the executive officers and club advisor.
