

# Lander University Technology Club

## **Article I – Purpose**

The purpose of the Lander Technology Club is to bring together members in the effort to further education in all things technological. This will be done by discussion, presentation, and hands on group work.

## **Article II – Membership**

Membership will be open to any faculty, staff or students taking at least 12 credit hours while maintaining a Lander GPA of 2.0.

## **Article III – Finances**

All operational costs will be obtained from willing club members. Fundraisers will be limited to philanthropic and educational purposes.

## **Article IV – Leadership**

The technology club will have an annually-elected President and Vice President. The President will be responsible for arranging and leading all club meetings. The Vice President is there to aid the President in leading the club and if for any reason the President is unable to fulfill their duties, it is the Vice President's job to fill in for them. If for some reason the President or Vice President resign or are unable to complete their duties, a new person will be elected at the next meeting.

## **Article V – Operations**

The club will meet every 1 to 2 weeks for one-two hours. Members will be notified via e-mail and Facebook group notification before every meeting takes place. Meetings will consist of either a technology-based presentation and discussion or a technology-oriented activity.

## **Article VI – Amendments**

All amendments to this constitution must be voted on by the members given a two-week notice. A vote of two thirds will be required for the amendment to take effect.
